



Because all of this at 50 years of age Nikola feels useless and filled with anger. He has beaten up his wife's new husband and has served a year of probation for it. Now he has no choice but to leave everything behind and to start a new chapter in his life. Unfortunately two days before the departure, the dog of Nikola's father goes missing. While searching for it Nikola has faced difficult questions about his own identity and lost connections with everyone he loves.

Pavel G. Vesnakov graduated from the New Bulgarian University in 2011 as a Bachelor of Visual Arts and Film Directing. He is one of the most successful young Bulgarian flm directors, known for his provocative ideas and deeply realistic flms that explore the degradation of modern Bulgarian society and the relationships between people. He is the screenwriter and director of the short flm trilogy Inches of Suburbia. It consists of three flms: Trains (2011), The Parafn Princess (2012) and Pride (2013). The parts of the trilogy have been shown at a number of international flm festivals such as the ISFF Clermont Ferrand, the IFF Locarno, Sarajevo IFF, ASIANA ISFF and many others. He has been awarded with more than 30 prestigious awards, including the Grand Prix for Best Film at the Clermont Ferrand Festival in France 2014 and Nomination for European Film Awards 2014. In 2015, with his latest short flm project, Zeus, Pavel won the Robert Bosch Foundation's grand prize for co-production with Eastern Europe. Anticipating an international scandal Khanlar turns to the National Security Department (NSD) to find his son. In the meantime Seymour's journey (both physical and metaphysical) becomes more and more fragmented. He arrives on an island of Kür Dili inhabited mostly by feral horses and one only mysterious human resident. Distant and sceptical of each other at first, the two loners gradually warm up to each other forming an unlikely bonding. However time keeps running out: the match is just around the corner as is the NSD...

He is puzzled by Otto's lack of showing grief and pursues a closer relation with the boy. Otto's universe is made up of the time he spends with his family, the daily visits to Laura's mother and the video excerpts made by Laura and Otto, while she was alive. Otto estranges himself from his friends. His aggression reflects in the music he plays and in the video recordings that he edits constantly, trying to create a memory of Laura. The video footage reveals the fact that he was filming Laura's suicide when it happened. As Costin and Otto become closer, Otto's inner world unfolds revealing the puzzle of his personality and his relationship with Laura. Otto the Barbarian kills the dragon and kisses the girl! is what Otto shouts right at the beginning. But what if the dragon already ate the girl?

Despite her being not so keen on the idea, Vassil goes to the Monastery where he finds out that the monk experiences an emotional breakdown and has been brought to a psychiatry. Vassil finds him there and convinces him to come and donate blood for his mother's surgery. He signs some documents to declare responsibility for Avtonom and gives him shelter at his own place, where the monk witnesses the anxious relationships in the director's family. Avtonom confesses to Vassil the reason for his emotional breakdown and the director faces a dilemma - to help his characters, or to keep filming them.

BIOGRAPHY:

In 1999, Svetoslav Draganov founded Cineaste Maudit Production in Sofia. In 2001, he received an award for the best Eastern-European film at Dok Leipzig 2001 for the documentary Life is wonderful, isn't it?The Merry Boys was shown at IDFA 2003, Young at Heart won the Prix Europa, Berlin in 2003. In 2005, Amateurs was awarded the Golden Rhyton for the best Bulgarian documentary, as well as the award of the Bulgarian critics. "Life Almost Wonderful" competed in 2013 at the IDFA's feature length competition, won the critics award at Golden Rhyton 2013, and was awarded with special jury prizes at the Sofia Film Festival 2014 and ZagrebDox 2014. Zhaleika which he produced was awarded with special jury prize at Generation section at Berlinale 2016 and won the Grand priz at Sofia Film Fest 2016. Waterfall CEO will be his feature fiction film
